1. The Announcement that public worship may resume from 10th May is very welcome. We need to be aware that this refers only to weekday and Sunday Mass at this time. The Government stipulation is that other religious ceremonies such as Communion and Confirmations should not take place at this time.

3. The situation regarding Baptisms remains the same until we hear otherwise, ie, the Sacrament of Baptism can only be celebrated in case of emergency.
4. We hope to resume public Mass from Monday 10th May. Maximum attendance is set at 50. Further details will be announced next Sunday.
