- God's never-ending love






4. The Sacrament of Reconciliation



This section and the section that follows will help you to explain to your child what will happen when they celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Practices way from parish to parish, so if you have any specific questions about what will happen on the day of your child's First Reconciliation, check with the priest or your child's teacher.

In celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation, our emphasis is always on the never-ending love and forgiveness of God, and so children need not be arvivous or worning about celebrating the sacrament for the first time. However, if your child is particularly shy or nervous about talking to the priset, think about asking them to draw a picture showing a time when they didn't live as Jesus asks. They can bring this to the priset, and talk to him about it. All the time reasure your child of God's love – and indeed your love – for them.
