**Pope Leo XIV's encyclical Magnifica Humanitas** is a sweeping moral, social, and theological response to the rise of artificial intelligence, arguing that AI must always serve the dignity, freedom, and flourishing of the human person. It warns against concentration of technological power, the erosion of truth, the militarization of AI, and the temptation to treat human beings as optimizable projects rather than persons. It calls governments, tech leaders, and societies to "disarm AI," regulate it responsibly, and ensure it strengthens—not replaces—human relationships, work, and moral judgment.
